‘NINE,’ Directed by Jennifer Campbell, Wins Award at the 2003 Rochester International Film Festival

May 8, 2003, BOSTON – ‘NINE,’ an uplifting documentary film telling the story of nine breast cancer survivors who rowed together in the world’s largest two-day rowing event, was presented as an award winner at the 2003 Rochester International Film Festival.

The 45th Annual Rochester International Film Festival took place from May 1-3, 2003 in Rochester, NY. Out of 191 entries, 75 were kept for final judging. From those, 33 were selected to screen at the festival. Those films that were screened, including “NINE,” were awarded trophies.

Director Jennifer Campbell was able to attend the festival, and was extremely pleased with the screening. “It was, by far, one of the best screenings yet. The video and sound projection was superb, and it was an honor to screen the film to such a large audience. I was truly honored to have been selected for recognition by the festival organizers.”

Taking its name from the startling statistic that one in nine women will contract breast cancer in her lifetime, ‘NINE’ tells the story of nine breast cancer survivors from across the United States as they race in the prestigious Head of the Charles Regatta in Boston, Mass. The film follows the women’s stories as they bond and share hope from their first meeting through the race. Holly Metcalf, an Olympic Gold Medallist, instructs the women in basic rowing.
